DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Use **BRILLIANT** in the dishwashing machine according to the manufacturer's instructions or at a concentration of 16 gram/10 litres of water. The working concentration should than be kept between 0,15 - 0,25 %, according to soil load and degree of water hardness. In the final rinse use our Rinse Aid to deliver a great shine.
