ORGANIC CHLORINE GRANULES FOR SWIMMING POOL WATER TREATMENT

PRODUCT USE:

CLEARON is an isocyanurate stabilized source of chlorine to disinfect swimming pool water thereby getting rid of undesirable bacteria and algae and to improve water clarity and colour. **CLEARON** is approved by the US Health Authorities for this purpose.

Organic carriers of chlorine are more stable than inorganic carriers and therefore considerably reducing chlorine loss from the pool water caused by sunlight. **CLEARON** assures that chlorine will be in the pool water with minimum effort on the part of the pool owner.

- High available chlorine content.
- Long lasting chlorine residual.
- No chlorine loss by sunlight decomposition.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Form: White granules.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Summer: Add 150 - 200 gram per 10.000 litres of water
Autumn: Add 100 - 150 gram per 10.000 litres of water
Winter: Add 50 - 100 gram per 10.000 litres of water

Estimating of pool capacity:

Rectangular Pool: length x width x average depth in meters x 1,000 = Total capacity in litres.
Circular Pool: 3,1459 x radius x radius x average depth x 1,000 = Total capacity in litres.

CAUTION: Never mix different pool chemicals together. Add separately to the pool water.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Never mix with acids, ammonium salts and amines.
- Take precautions with cationic formulations.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Store product in well-ventilated area.
- Do NOT swallow.
