

SOLVENE 33

PRODUCT USE:

SOLVENE 33 is ideal for cleaning and degreasing electrical equipment, transformers, business machines, ignition systems and radar equipment.

ADVANTAGES:

- Cold cleaning - does not require heat.
- Fast dissolving action on oils, greases, waxes and tars.
- Non-corrosive to metals, including aluminium.
- Safe for use on bare metals, painted surfaces, plastics, rubber and ceramics.
- Safe in use - does not contain tetrachloride. High flash point.
- Replaces toxic and flammable solvents.
- Leaves no residue. Does not promote electrical conduction on cleaned surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

SOLVENE 33 may be applied by any of the following methods:

- 1.) By immersion of the parts in the solvent, in a tank or in agitating equipment.
- 2.) In slush cleaning equipment, where the solvent is circulated and flowed onto the parts to be cleaned.
- 3.) In spray cleaning equipment, particularly for cleaning prior to overhauling of electric motors and generators.
- 4.) Hand spraying, brushing or wiping.
- 5.) Ultra-sonic cleaning equipment.

Please note: Test effect of product on new types of plastics and other surfaces before general use.

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PRECAUTIONS:

- Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with the skin. Wear suitable protective gear. Toxic.
- Use in well-ventilated environment. Take care not to let it enter airways.
- Keep out of reach of children.
